

Visa Requirements to THAILAND

- Passenger is allowed to embark and disembark in Thailand. Kindly refer to below visa table.
- Visa on arrival & Handling Fee of Immigration sums up to total 108SGD.
- Passenger not required to purchase travel insurance.

Summary of Countries and Territories entitled for Visa Exemption and Visa on Arrival to Thailand

1. Ordinary Passport

Passport holders of the following countries/territories who may enter Thailand under a tourist Visa Exemption scheme:

Kazakhstan- till 31 Aug 2024
India and Taiwan- 10 Nov 23 to 10 May 24

2. VISA ON ARRIVAL

Passport holders of the following countries/territories must have a valid visa prior.

Or may apply for VOA:

Bhutan, Bulgaria,
Cyprus,
Ethiopia,
Fiji,
Georgia,
Kazakhstan,
Malta, Mexico,
Nauru,
Papua New Guinea,
Romania,
Uzbekistan,
Vanuatu.

3. Bilateral Agreement

In addition, passport holders of the following countries/ territories may enter Thailand without a visa under a bilateral agreement:

Cambodia (14 days)
Hong Kong (30 days)
Laos (30 days)
Macau (30 days), Mongolia (30 days)
Russia (30 days and VOA)
Vietnam (30 days)
Argentina (90 days)
Brazil (90 days)
Chile (90 days)
South Korea (90 days)
Peru (90 days)
